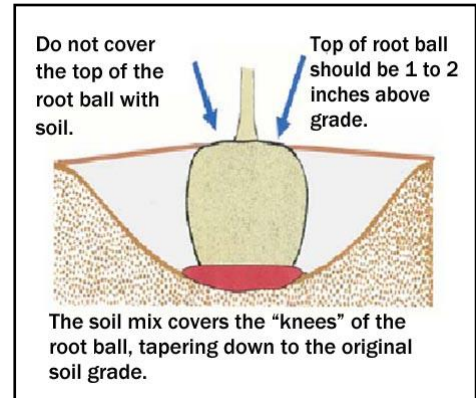


# Wilmore's Guide to Planting Trees and Shrubs

- Dig your hole 2 to 3 times the width of your root ball, but no deeper.
- Remove plant from container by gently turning plant and pot upside down or on its side and cutting away pot.
- Slice or score 3 inches into the root ball of trees and shrubs, and pull the roots of smaller plants apart to encourage new root growth.
- Wet root ball with a mixture of **Ferti-Lome Root Stimulator** and water. For 5-year warranty, also coat the root ball with **Myke** powder. Use 2 cups for shrub and 4 to 6 cups for trees.
- Place plant in hole. Be sure top of the root ball is slightly above grade.
- Mix 1/3 **Ferti-lome Peat Moss** or **EKO Compost** to 2/3 soil from hole. Fill in around plant.
- Water thoroughly with root stimulator mixture. If soil settles below grade, add more soil mix and water.
- Check plant twice a day to see if it needs water. Water monthly (or more often) during the winter if ground is not frozen.

**To redeem your warranty:** Should your tree or shrub die within the warranty period, please bring us a large cutting from the dead item and a photo of the whole plant. Also, don't forget to bring your receipt showing the date of purchase, the plant, and the above items. We will replace your dead item with the same plant, or something similar if we don't have the same item in stock.
